All new and returning K-6 students should enrolled/registered ONLINE by August 18, 2023. Reminder: You will need to complete the Busing Request form and Weekend Food Bag request online when you register, so be sure to look for those forms once you are on the website.

- \* Elementary School Pictures (K 6) will be taken during Open House on August 15 from 4 7 pm
- \* Preschool 3 year olds, 4 year olds and ECSE will have their pictures taken on September 6th
- \*Kindergarten "Parent Meeting & Student Assessments" will be August 21-22, 2023
  - \* A time has been pre-arranged for you and is enclosed with this letter.
- \* The first day of school for students in grades 1-6 is Monday, August 21, 2023
- \* Kindergarten classes begin on Wednesday, August 23, 2023 (all day, every day)
- \* Early Childhood Special Education, Discover Time and VPK School Readiness begins Monday, August 28, 2023
- \* Regular School hours for elementary students is from 8:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m.
- \* Breakfast will be served from 7:35 7:55 a.m. for all elementary students and is FREE. Lunch is FREE this year.

  We have enclosed an Application for Educational Benefits form in this mailing. It's critical that we have EVERY FAMILY complete the form even if you don't feel you may quality. This helps generate government money for our school which is very important for us to function.

Up-to-date School immunizations are mandated by State Law for all K-12 students to enter school. New Kindergarten students and new students to the district will also need to have a copy of their birth certificates as mandated by State Law, along with a copy of immunizations.
