MN Twins Let's Play Ball Baseball Clinic-Brown County REA and Sleepy Eye Community Education are teaming up with the MN Twins to offer this FREE youth clinic. In case of inclement weather, the event will be moved into Sleepy Eye Public School. Preschool Opportunities

Do you have a 3 or 4-year-old that is ready to begin preschool? The schools in Sleepy Eye offer this educational opportunity during the year.

Sleepy Eye ECFE coordinates a 3-year-old preschool called **Discovery Time**. The group meets three days a week in a morning or afternoon section. It is supported by parental fees, scholarships and Minnesota Department of Education levy and aid.

Four year olds participate in **Voluntary Pre-K**, with classes meeting most days of the week. Sleepy Eye received a Voluntary Pre-K grant which provides tuition free preschool for four year olds. Busing is available within city limits for participants. Call 507-794-7873 for more details or to register a child for the 2021-2022 school year.

St. Mary's Preschool offers an option of three or four half days for four year olds. Sessions are three hours long with transportation available within Sleepy Eye. Three-year-old preschool meets two days a week with two hour sessions. Payment schedules are available. Contact St. Mary's at 507-794-6141 for more details and to register.
