Explore Nature: Outdoor Hands On Learning Experiences

Join members of the Sleepy Eye Youth Eco Solutions Team (YES!) with their coaches, Deb Reinarts and Mary Beth Botz, as we explore various locations of natural habitats around Sleepy Eye, including prairie, parks and Sleepy Eye Lake. We will "tee" off at the Sleepy Eye Golf Course on day one to discover what the prairie habitats give us, and to learn about soils, seeds, and insects. On day two and three we will continue activities relating to life around us in our native land. We will observe, collect, experiment, use art, storytelling, and more! Participants will each receive a science kit and insect net for our activities and to keep. Second year students can explore new areas with new activities as well as mentor new participants. All materials used are supplied from the school and STEM grant curriculum.

Preschool Opportunities

Do you have a 3 or 4-year-old that is ready to begin preschool? The schools in Sleepy Eye offer this educational opportunity during the year. Call 507-794-7873 for more details or to register a child for the 2023-2024 school year.

<u>Sleepy Eye ECFE</u> coordinates a three year old preschool called <u>Discovery Time</u>. The group will meet three days a week during the 2023-2024 school year for a morning or afternoon section. It is supported by parental fees, scholarships and Minnesota Department of Education levy and aid.

Four year olds participate in <u>Voluntary Pre-K</u>, with classes meeting most days of the week. Sleepy Eye received a Voluntary Pre-K grant which provides tuition free preschool for four year olds. Busing is available within city limits for participants.

<u>St. Mary's Preschool</u> offers an option of three or four half days for four year olds. Sessions are three hours long with transportation available within Sleepy Eye. Three year old preschool meets two days a week with two and a half hour sessions. Payment schedules are available. Contact St. Mary's at 507-794-6141 for more details and to register.

Ride Safe, Ride Smart! Motorcycle Safety Training

Are you ready to ride? Always wanted to ride? Been riding on a motorcycle permit for years? It's time to hit the road! It's time to get legal! RSRS is recognized by the National Motorcycle Safety Foundation and licensed by the Minnesota Department of Public Safety. All Rider Courses are held at the Sleepy Eye High School and are limited to 8 riders. Refresher courses are available for experienced riders. Moped courses are also available online.

Course requirements: Participants must be at least 16 years old and possess a valid driver's license. Parents of those under 18 must sign a consent/release form prior to riding instruction. Participants must furnish their own protective riding gear: eye protection, long sleeves, long pants, full-fingered gloves, over-the-ankle footwear and a DOT approved helmet. Participants must also be able to ride a bicycle, as the skill of balancing is not taught in this course.

Saturday and Sunday classes are offered at Sleepy Eye on the following dates: May 6-7, June 3-4, June 24-25, July 8-9, August 5-6 and August 19-20, September 9-10. Courses typically run from 9:00 am-3:00 pm. Fee is \$270.00.
