

Patient Eligibility Screening Record for Adults 19 Years of Age or Older

For sites enrolled in the Uninsured and Underinsured Adult Vaccine (UUAV) program

Providers are required to screen at each visit in order to know if patients are eligible for the UUAV program and which stock of vaccine to use at that visit. This same record may be used for all subsequent visits as long as the patient's eligibility status has not changed. Retain this record (or equivalent paper or electronic record) for three years following the date(s) of vaccine administration.
